

Suggested Pathways for a Lesson Plan

Please note: these pathways are just optional suggestions for drawing inspiration — as are the above tips and strategies.

The CCT was designed to be flexible, so feel free to engage with and implement the CCT to best suit your classroom environment, your students, and your teaching style.



I Only Have 5 - 15 Minutes; What Can I Do?

- **View a chapter clip** — then ask students to free-write based on the self-reflection prompt and/or lead a discussion using the provided question guide.
- **Engage in classroom discussion** — then assign an SEL activity, the test-your-knowledge quiz, or self-reflection prompt as homework.
- **Assign students to do an SEL activity as bell work.** Then, ask students to share about it, or use the tip sheet and/or at-home discussion guide to lead a conversation, at home — and become “SEL Champions” beyond the classroom.



I Have 20 - 30 Minutes; What Can I Do?

- **Use an SEL activity as bell work or introductory activity,** then view a chapter clip and engage in student self-reflection and/or classroom discussion.
- **View multiple chapter clips** — taking the time in between for students to self reflect and/or lead discussion about what they have just experienced. Optionally, assign an SEL activity or the test-your-knowledge quiz as homework.
- **View a chapter clip, engage in discussion, then assign an SEL activity** so students can learn about, and reflect on, how the film topics relate to their own lives and their ability to positively impact themselves, others, and their broader communities.
